2. All volunteers **must** attend orientation **prior** to volunteering. Volunteer orientation is every Monday (excluding Redwood holidays) at 3:30 p.m. and typically takes an hour.
3. To sign up for orientation, please visit [www.redwoodnky.org/be-a-volunteer.aspx](http://www.redwoodnky.org/be-a-volunteer.aspx) and download the orientation schedule and return it to the Community Outreach specialist using the options listed on the form.
4. Spring Gardening will be available Monday through Friday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. or every third Saturday beginning in March.
5. Volunteer hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. In some instances, Saturdays are available beginning the third Saturday in March and every third Saturday thereafter.
6. Volunteers 18 and over wanting to work in the program areas must complete a background check, which takes 1-2 weeks to process prior to volunteering. There is a \$25 processing due at the time paperwork is received.
7. In order to qualify for the Disney program, Redwood requires eight hours of volunteer service.
